REGULAR MEETING FEBRUARY 13, 2012

The Regular Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of New Bremen, County of Lewis and the State of New York was held at the Town Municipal Office Building, 8420 State Rte. 812, New Bremen, New York on the 13th day of February 2012.

Supervisor Keys called the meeting to order at 5:15 p.m. with the Pledge to the Flag led by Councilman Becker.

RESOLUTION NO. 27 OF 2012 APPROVAL OF MINUTES

On a motion of Councilman Becker, seconded by Councilman M. Bush, the following resolution was ADOPTED Ayes 5 Becker, M. Bush, R. Bush, Sauer, Keys Nays 0

Resolved the minutes of the January 5, 9 & 23, 2012 meetings are approved.

PRIVILEGE OF FLOOR

Bruce Widrick, Mayor of the Village of Croghan, asked that contract money for the Croghan Volunteer Fire Department and contracts for ambulance services and fire protection be sent to the Village along with contracts to be approved by the Village also. Clerk Jones will review both contracts to be sure both entities are included in the signing of the contracts. Supervisor Keys stated that this year's contract money is already to be sent to the Village.

COUNCIL MEMBER REPORTS

Councilman R. Bush invited Bill Schaab, Insurance Agent at North Country Estates Ins. Co., to review the Towns insurance policy. Mr. Schaab reviewed the 2012 insurance package with the board and answered their questions or concerns.

Resolved Pursuant to the provisions of Section 284 of the Highway Law we agree that moneys levied and collected in the Town for the repair and improvement of highways, shall be expended as follows:

General Repairs. The sum of \$334,965.00 shall be set aside to be expended for primary work and general repairs upon 64.73 miles of town highways, including sluices, culverts and bridges having a span of less than five feet and boardwalks or the renewals thereof.

Clerk Jones asked for permission to attend the New York State Town Clerk's Association conference being held April 22 – 25, 2012 in Saratoga Springs, New York. After discussion the following resolution was presented.

HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT

Mr. Hall asked for permission to advertise for bids for bank run gravel for 2012. He also asked the Board for permission to purchase a new pay loader and trade in the 2003 CAT loader which has 6300 hours on it. He talked with John Deere – offered \$47,500 for trade, CAT – offered \$42,000 for trade & Case – offered \$48,160. CAT has the highest resale value. Discussion followed. The Board decided to table until our next Board meeting and will discuss further. Supervisor Keys will look over the accounting aspect and determine if there is enough money in the budget and where.

COUNTY UPDATE

Legislator Boyd reported that the Lewis Co. Board of Legislator's did not vote on the "proposed walking trail" and railroad issue. Joanne Dicob stated she is against the county taking over the railroad and creating a walking trail system. They will get the land and right of way to the property and will be tax exempt. Discussion followed. After discussion the following resolution was presented. Supervisor Keys will send a letter to the Lewis Co. Board of Legislator's along with a copy of said resolution.

RESOLUTION NO. 36 OF 2012 OPPOSING THE LEWIS COUNTY RECREATIONAL TRAIL DEVELOPMENT

Whereas; the County of Lewis is considering creating a Recreational Trail on the Mohawk Adirondack and Northern Railroad, and

Whereas; the Town Board believes it would be of little or no benefit to the residents of the Town of New Bremen and/or the residents of Lewis County, and

Whereas; the Town Board also believes that during these economic times, such expenditures are totally unreasonable and uncalled for, now therefore

Be It Resolved; that the Town Board of the Town of New Bremen opposes the development of the Lewis County Recreational Trail.

SUPERVISOR

Supervisor Keys reported he is having trouble setting up the QuickBooks program. He contacted two local accounting firms for quotes to set up the program and/or for full accounting for the Town. Prices ranged from \$600-\$900 to set up the program for the Supervisor to use himself – by Nagy & Croniser and up to \$500 a month to do all accounting for the Supervisor – by Accounting Essentials. The program is currently on Supervisor Keys personal computer. This could cause FOIL issues, etc. in the future. The board discussed purchasing a laptop for the Supervisor to use for Town purpose only. Assessor Gratch suggested checking with Doug Nagy, IT Director for the county, to obtain a price quote for a new laptop through them. Supervisor Keys will look into it.

CO. HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN

The Lewis Co. Senior Planner, Monique Branagan sent an email asking the Town Board to adopt the County's Hazard Mitigation Plan. After discussion the following resolution was presented and also approved Supervisor Keys and Councilman M. Bush be named to the local hazard mitigation planning committee.

Whereas; the County of Lewis, with the assistance from Monique Branagan, Senior Planner, has gathered information and prepared the Lewis Co. Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan; and

Whereas; the Lewis Co. Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan has been prepared in accordance with FEMA requirements at 44 C.F.R. 201.6; and

Whereas; the County of Lewis is a local unit of government that has afforded the citizens an opportunity to comment and provide input in the Plan and the actions in the Plan; and

Whereas; the Town of New Bremen has reviewed the Plan and affirms that the Plan will be updated no less than every five years;

Now Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Town of New Bremen that the County of Lewis adopts the Lewis Co. Multi-Jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan as this jurisdiction's Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan, and resolves to execute the actions in the Plan.

SEARCH & RESUCE

Pete McLane of the Beaver Falls Fire District is against the Lewis Co. Search & Rescue obtaining a Certificate of Need (CON) for their ambulance certificate. They only use Search & Rescue for Advanced Life Support (ALS) and have David Kuhl on call (every other day) for the Beaver Falls and Croghan Fire Departments with a possible six (6) new ALS providers by the end of the year. It could possibly force the local ambulances out of business and for that reason is asking the Board to rescind their positive resolution supporting Lewis Co. Search & Rescue and their CON. After discussion the following resolution was presented. Supervisor Key's will forward a letter along with said resolution.
