Lloyd Richardson from BRCS asked about the possibility of putting a cross walk from school parking lot to Addison Ave. Spoke with Donny Mattimore at NYSDOT he will check with the traffic and safety law department. The Board is concerned of student safety as there is no sidewalk along Addison Ave. and feels it would be best the state handle it. On hold at this time.
- 4. Billed school for sand they got over the winter. Councilman Aucter suggested having a shared services agreement with the school for sand, snow removal etc.
- 5. Issue between Frontier and Tom Marriott concerning placement of utility poles on his property, within Town right of way. Out of the Boards hands.
- 6. Summer Youth program still on hold.
- 7. Upcoming projects finish River Road project, driveway culverts, road culvert replacements, clean up of trees on roadside and start mowing. Councilman Aucter would like Mr. Herzig to draw up an agreement once work is complete on the River Road and have all parties sign off.

SOLAR PROJECT - DISCUSSION

1. Board reviewed the retainer agreement sent by CMBK law firm along with a bill received for services, which the Board is confused with as they have only prepared their proposal for retainer agreement. Councilwoman Buell would like the legal representation contract to state it is "contingent on the availability and amount of Intervener funds issued by the State of New York". The Board is not comfortable signing the agreement at this time. Supervisor Keys will contact CMBK for clarification on both documents.

SOLAR LAW

Board reviewed "proposed" Local Law No. 1 of 2020 – Regulation of Solar Energy Systems in the Town of New Bremen and completed the FEAF parts 1, 2 and 3. Said proposed local law is to be referred to the County Planning Board for their review and recommendations. After review and discussion, the following resolutions were presented.
